

# Basic Camp Packing List

## **Campers for all camps should remember to bring the following:**

Sleeping Bag (or other bedding)

Pillow

Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, shampoo, conditioner, hairbrush, soap, etc.)

Towel

Swimsuit\*

Appropriate Clothing sufficient for 6 days of camp\*

Sleep Wear

Closed Toed shoes

Flip Flops (for the bathhouse and pool)

Sunscreen

Flashlight

Water Bottle

\*see dress code for detailed description of camp-appropriate attire

## **Campers may want to bring:**

Personal Bible (If the camper does not have access to a Bible, a camp Bible can be provided.)

A Camera (Cameras and other personal items are the camper's responsibility. Disposable cameras are available at the camp store.)

Bug Repellant (Camp Stoney does not have a problem with biting bugs, but campers may bring repellant nonetheless, if they desire.)

Shower Caddy (to carry items to bathhouse)

A Hat

Sunglasses

Chapstick

Books

Playing Cards

Writing Paper, pens, envelopes, stamps, etc.

**Campers are advised NOT to bring:**

Snacks

Pocket Money

Camping Knives

Expensive/Irreplaceable items

Electronic Devices (cell phones, Sony PSPs, mp3 players, etc.) aside from a camera

(If a camper brings any of the above items, those items will be safely kept in the office until sign-out.)

**Campers are PROHIBITED from bringing:**

Weapons (firearms, explosives, firecrackers, undeclared knives, etc.)

Inappropriate Literature or images

Illegal Substances

Alcohol

(possession of a prohibited item will result in immediate confiscation of said item and possible dismissal from camp at parent/guardian expense)

**For registration, parents should bring all application forms, medical forms, applicable release and consent forms, and a list of any contact information and special camper needs (allergies, medical restrictions, etc.).**
