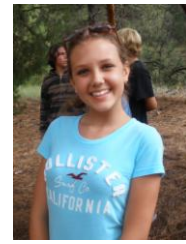


Camp Stoney Summer Schedule 2010



May 28-May 30 OR June 11-13 **Family Camp I**—all ages—parents required
 Come for a weekend with your family; this camp provides a great way to introduce younger children to camp or give families quality time sharing their faith together. *Fee: \$75 adults, \$50 children*

June 13-19 **Sr. High Adventure Camp**—grades 9th-12th (limited to 30 campers)
 Adventure Camp offers wilderness backpacking, camping, and rafting off campus, and work on the low and high ropes course, rock climbing, Bible study and dynamic worship in God's creation. *Fees: \$350 + rafting \$100*

June 20-26 **Harry Potter Camp**—grades 3rd-8th
 Explore the Christian themes in this popular series through Bible study and worship. This year features new arts & crafts, Quidditch, swimming, archery, and day hiking. This is a great way to share Jesus with your friends! *Fee: \$350*

June 20-26 **Outdoor Adventure Camp**—grades 3rd-6th
 This camp could be described as the pre-quel to Jr. High Adventure Camp and focuses on outdoor skills such as day hiking and sleeping under the stars, as well as building a strong relationship with Jesus. Also, explore more traditional camp activities, low ropes, arts & crafts and field games. *Fee: \$350*

June 27-July 3 **Jr. High Adventure Camp**—grades 6th-9th (limited to 30 campers)
 This camp introduces early teens to rugged outdoor skills through wilderness backpacking, camping, and rafting off campus, rock climbing in a gym setting, work on the ropes course, Bible study, and dynamic worship *Fees: \$350 + rafting \$50*

June 27-July 3 **Quilt Camp**—grades 3rd-10th
 Campers will make their very own quilt during two hands-on sessions per day with legendary Albuquerque quilter Leta Brazell. Children will make a split-rail quilt, as well as experience all the other fun activities that camp offers. *Fees: \$350 + \$125 for all materials*

June 27-July 3 **Arts & Crafts Camp**—grades 3rd-10th
 An opportunity for children to experiment with different art forms and mediums: pottery, watercolor painting, photography, creative writing, and more, while getting to know the Creator in whose image we are made. *Fees: \$350 + \$50 materials*

July 4-10 **Jr. High Adventure Camp II**—grades 6th-9th (limited to 30 campers)
 This camp introduces early teens to rugged outdoor skills through wilderness backpacking, camping, and rafting off campus, rock climbing in a gym setting, work on the ropes course, Bible study, and dynamic worship. *Fees: \$350 + rafting \$50*

July 4-10 **Narnia Camp—Voyage of the Dawn Treader**—grades 3rd-8th
 Experience *The Voyage of the Dawn Treader* beyond the movie. Grow in your relationship with Jesus by exploring C. S. Lewis' world through drama, Bible study, worship, arts & crafts. Enjoy archery, swimming, and making new friends. *Fee: \$350*

July 5-11 **Summer Fun Camp**—grades 3rd-10th
 A traditional summer camp format including age appropriate worship & Bible study, swimming, field games, archery, hiking, ropes course, arts & crafts, campfires, and lots of fun. *Fee: \$350*

July 5-11 **Nature Camp**—grades 3rd-8th
 This camp will offer children and youth the chance to learn more about the natural world around them, explore ways to live a greener life, and get to know the Creator of it all. *Fee: \$350*

July 18-24 **Grace Camp**—grades 3rd-6th
 This special outreach ministry provides a camping experience for children with a family member in prison. Volunteers and donations are needed to support this ministry. *Scholarships provided for all*

July 18-24 **Sr. High Leadership Camp**—grades 8th-12th
 This camp offers teens a chance for creative fun and an opportunity to serve. Campers will explore the call of Christ on their life through Bible study and worship, and will reach out to fellow campers through a dramatic presentation of *The Legend of the Three Trees*. *Fee: \$350*
